## CalFresh Outreach Basics Developing County Partnerships

## Establishing county partnerships is essential to best serve students in meeting their basic needs, especially under CalFresh.

<u>Assembly Bill 1326</u> was established to strengthen relationships between public higher education campuses and county welfare departments by designating at least 1 to 2 campus staff (CalFresh Outreach Coordinator, Basic Needs Manager, etc.) who can serve as a point of contact for county staff and vice versa. Your campus can submit a campus liaison through the <u>CFO Resource Hub Support Desk</u>.

For campuses who have not established a county partnership and wish to reach out to your county liaison to begin forming those partnerships, you may use the <u>county contact list</u>.
